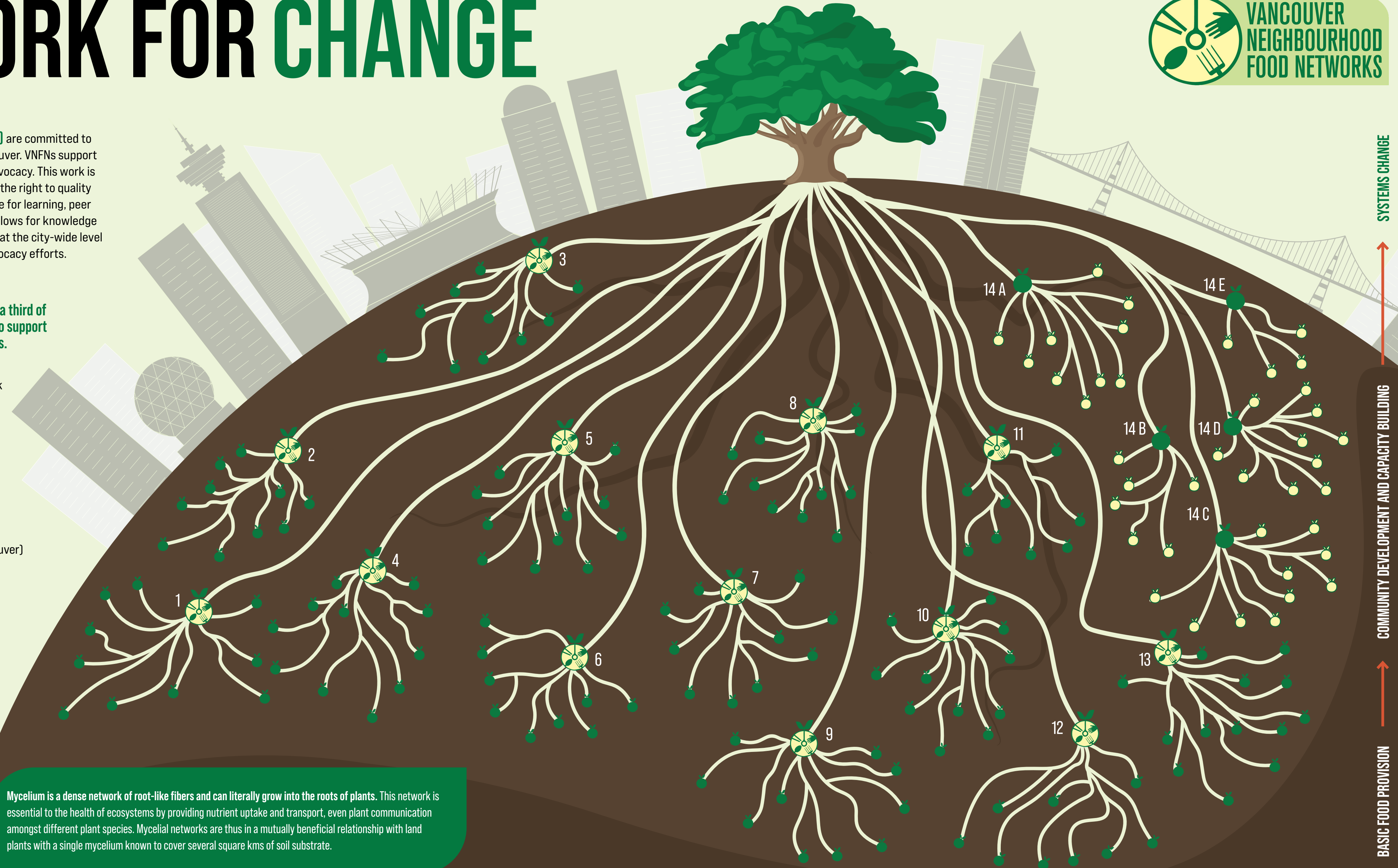
These top 10 individual Network's partners represent a third of the total 349 partnerships city-wide and which help to support unique neighbourhood needs and program focus areas.

Mycelium is a dense network of root-like fibers and can literally grow into the roots of plants. This network is essential to the health of ecosystems by providing nutrient uptake and transport, even plant communication amongst different plant species. Mycelial networks are thus in a mutually beneficial relationship with land plants with a single mycelium known to cover several square kms of soil substrate.
